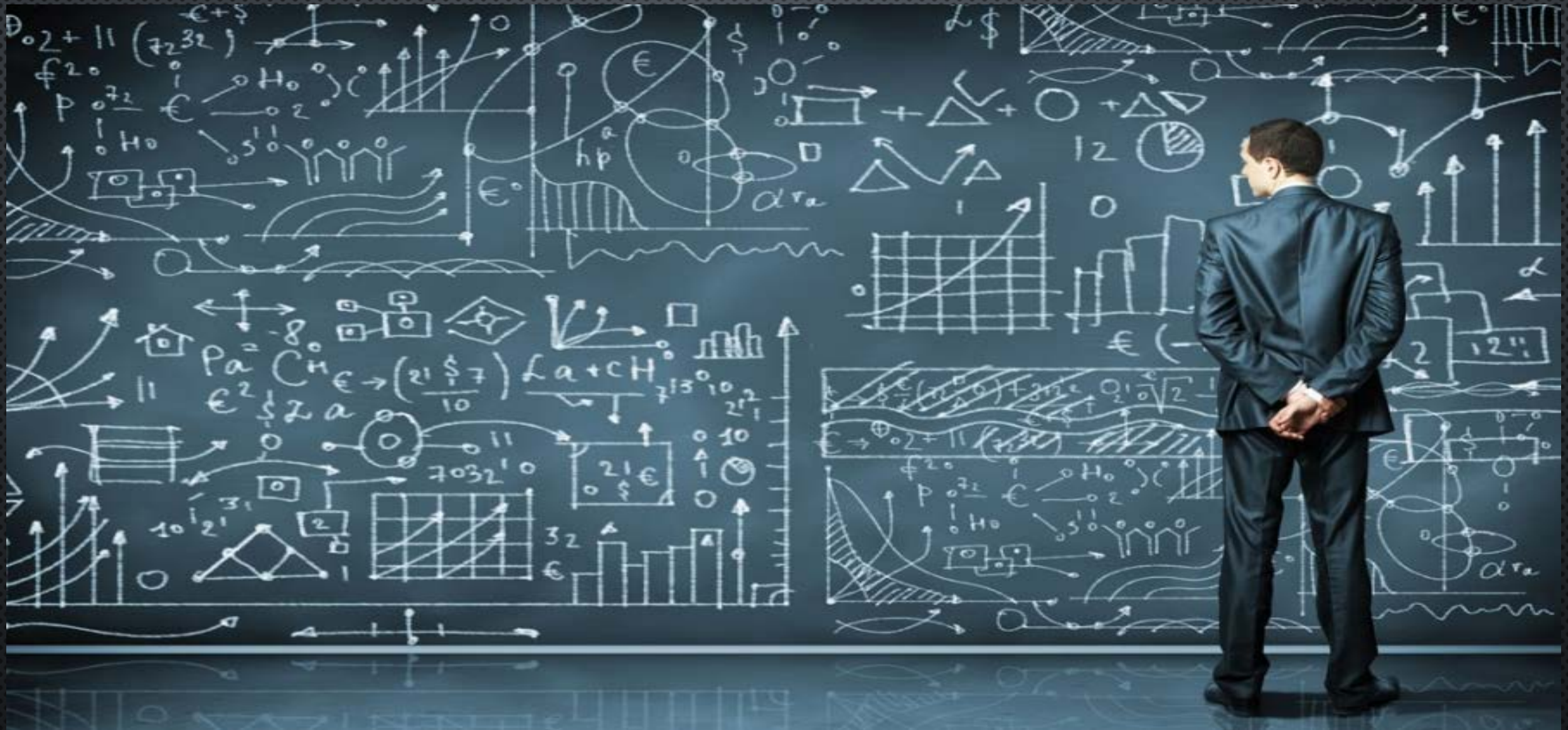

- ALL OTHER DIVISIONS OFFER PARTIAL (EQUIVALENCY) SCHOLARSHIPS, EXCEPT D3 WHICH OFFERS ONLY EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

# SCHOLARSHIP OFFERS

- ALL OFFERS ARE “VERBAL AGREEMENTS” UNTIL SIGNING DAY (NATIONAL LETTER OF INTENT, NLI)
  - FEB OR LATER (SR YEAR) – NORMAL SIGNING DAY
  - DEC (SR YEAR) – EARLY SIGNING DAY
- THE SCHOOL CAN RESCIND THE OFFER AT ANY TIME FOR ANY REASON UNTIL THE NLI IS SIGNED – THE NLI IS A BINDING CONTRACT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL AND STUDENT
- IT IS A 1-YEAR CONTRACT (ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS ARE USUALLY A 4-YR CONTRACT)
- NLI IS VERY DIFFERENT FROM THE NIL
  - NLI = NATIONAL LETTER OF INTENT (YOUR CONTRACT FOR ALL/PART OF YOUR EDUCATION TO BE PAID FOR)
  - NIL = NAME/IMAGE/LIKENESS (OFFERS THE ABILITY FOR STUDENT ATHLETES TO BENEFIT FINANCIALLY BEYOND THEIR SCHOLARSHIP)

# SCHOLARSHIP OFFERS

CAN VARY GREATLY:

- FULL (HEADCOUNT) OR PARTIAL (EQUIVLANECY)
- FOR EQUIVALENCY SCHOLARSHIPS: ACADEMICS CAN HELP OFFSET THE REST OF PARTIAL

  - I.E. CLEMSON
    - THEIR CLASS OF 2024 BOARD IS ALREADY SET
    - THEY HAVE STARTED ON 2025/2026 ALREADY

- ALL THE OTHERS
  - THEIR RADAR IS SET BY SEPTEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> THE YEAR BEFORE SIGNING DAY
  - THEY KNOW WHO THEY ARE TARGETING, OFFERS ARE HANDED OUT ACCORDINGLY
  - I.E. GEORGIA SOUTHERN
    - THEIR CLASS OF 2024 BOARD IS A LITTLE FLUID
    - SUMMER CAMPS MAY CHANGE THEIR BOARD
    - THEY WILL START ON 2025 BY THANKSGIVING

# FCS

- 125 SCHOOLS
- SOME ARE FULL SCHOLARSHIP –TUITION, ROOM/BOARD, BOOKS, MEALS
- THEY ARE BROKEN INTO 2 CATEGORIES
  - SCHOLARSHIP – 106 SCHOOLS
    - CAN OFFER FULL OR PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIPS
    - WOFFORD AND TENNESSEE TECH
  - NON – SCHOLARSHIP (PIONEER & IVY) – 19 SCHOOLS
    - STETSON

# FCS – IVY LEAGUE

- 8 SCHOOLS “NON-SCHOLARSHIP”
- THEIR RADAR IS SIMILAR TO FBS TOP 25
- THEY KNOW WHO THEIR CLIENTELE IS BY JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup> THE YEAR BEFORE SIGNING DAY
- SAT II SUBJECT AREA EXAM (REQUIRED AT PRINCETON, LEAGUE IS LOOKING TO MANDATE)
- BAND SYSTEM
  - 4 BANDS (BASED UPON GPA & TEST SCORE)
    - HIGH BAND – CAN TAKE AS MANY AS THEY WANT
    - LOW BAND – CAN ONLY TAKE 2 / YEAR (RESERVED FOR SPECIAL PLAYERS)
- VERY PROTECTIVE OF SIGNEES
  - WILL LOSE A BAND ALLOCATION DUE TO FAILED SIGNINGS

## DIVISION I - HYPOTHETICAL

- IF EVERY FBS SCHOOL SIGNS 25 / YEAR
- 3,200 SIGN
- IF EVERY FCS SCHOOL SIGN 18 / YEAR
- 2,250 SIGN
- $1,088,158 / 4 \text{ HIGH SCHOOL GRADES} = 272,040$
- 5,250 DIVISION I SIGNEES
- $5,250 / 272,040 = .019 = 1.9\%$  OF HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL SENIORS SIGN DIVISION I EACH YEAR
- THIS NUMBER MAY BE CUT IN HALF NOW WITH THE PORTAL

- Younger athletes can contact coaches but will not get a response.

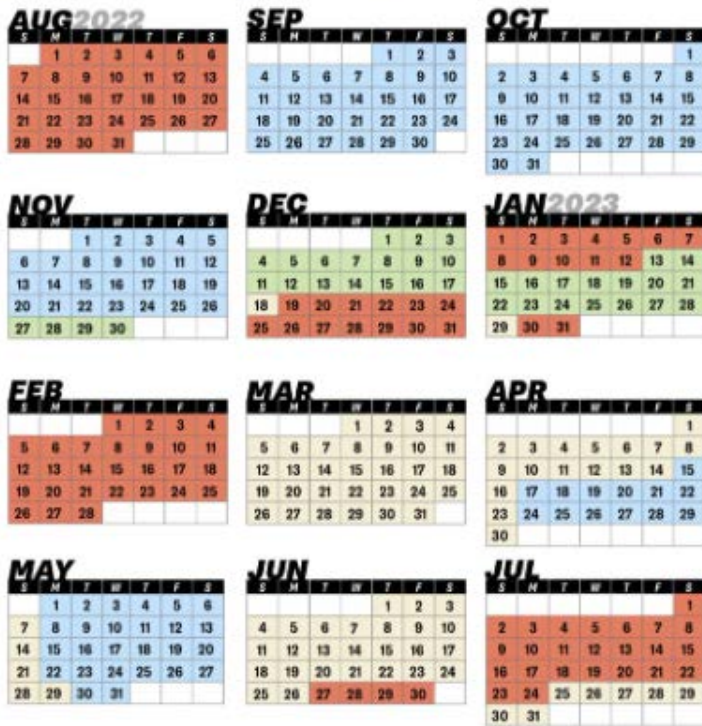

### Division I Football Bowl Subdivision

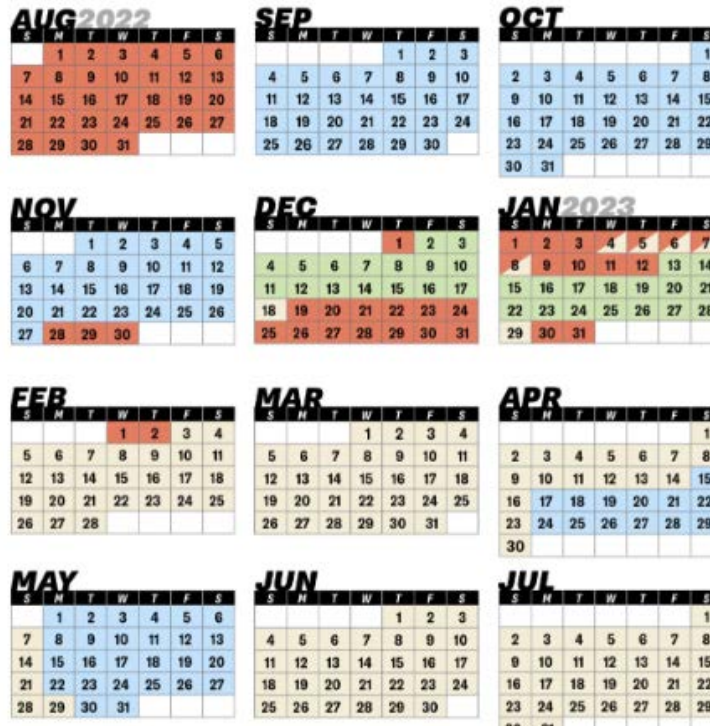

### Division I Football Championship Subdivision

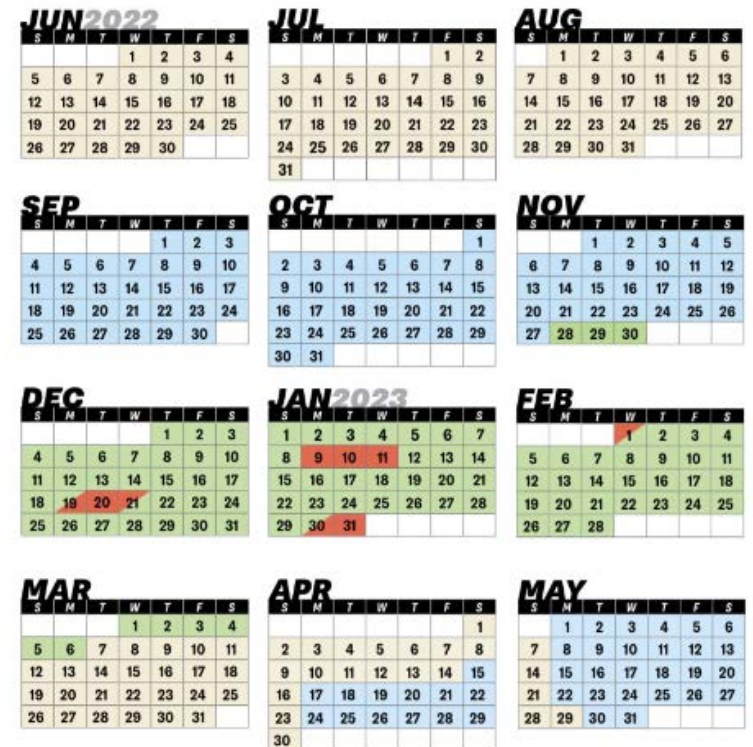

# DIVISION I – ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- NCAA DIVISION I INITIAL - ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS
  - **INITIAL FULL-TIME COLLEGIATE ENROLLMENT ON OR AFTER AUGUST 1, 2016:**
- **SIXTEEN (16) CORE COURSES** ARE REQUIRED
- TEN (10) CORE COURSES COMPLETED BEFORE THE SEVENTH SEMESTER; SEVEN (7) OF THE 10 MUST BE IN ENGLISH, MATH OR NATURAL/PHYSICAL SCIENCE.
- THESE COURSES/GRADES ARE "LOCKED IN" AT START OF THE SEVENTH SEMESTER (CANNOT BE REPEATED FOR GRADE-POINT AVERAGE [GPA] IMPROVEMENT TO MEET INITIAL-ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPETITION).
- *STUDENTS WHO DO NOT MEET CORE-COURSE PROGRESSION REQUIREMENTS MAY STILL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ATHLETICS AID AND PRACTICE IN THE INITIAL YEAR OF ENROLLMENT BY MEETING ACADEMIC REDSHIRT REQUIREMENTS*

# DIVISION I – ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- **TEST SCORES: (ACT/SAT)**
- STUDENTS MUST PRESENT A CORRESPONDING TEST SCORE AND CORE-COURSE GPA ON THE SLIDING SCALE.
- **SAT:** CRITICAL READING AND MATH SECTIONS.
- BEST SUBSCORE FROM EACH SECTION IS USED TO DETERMINE THE *SAT COMBINED SCORE* FOR INITIAL ELIGIBILITY.
- **ACT:** ENGLISH, MATH, READING AND SCIENCE SECTIONS.
- BEST SUBSCORE FROM EACH SECTION IS USED TO DETERMINE THE *ACT SUM SCORE* FOR INITIAL ELIGIBILITY.
- ALL ACT AND SAT ATTEMPTS *BEFORE* INITIAL FULL-TIME COLLEGIATE ENROLLMENT MAY BE USED FOR INITIAL ELIGIBILITY.
- **ENTER 9999 DURING ACT OR SAT REGISTRATION TO ENSURE THE TESTING AGENCY REPORTS YOUR SCORE DIRECTLY TO THE NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER. *TEST SCORES ON TRANSCRIPTS WILL NOT BE USED.***

# DIVISION I – ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- **CORE GRADE-POINT AVERAGE:**
- ONLY CORE COURSES THAT APPEAR ON THE HIGH SCHOOL'S LIST OF NCAA COURSES ON THE NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER'S WEBSITE ([WWW.ELIGIBILITYCENTER.ORG](http://WWW.ELIGIBILITYCENTER.ORG)) WILL BE USED TO CALCULATE YOUR CORE-COURSE GPA. USE THIS LIST AS A GUIDE.
- STUDENTS MUST PRESENT A CORRESPONDING TEST SCORE (ACT SUM SCORE OR SAT COMBINED SCORE) AND CORE-COURSE GPA (MINIMUM 2.300) ON SLIDING SCALE B.
- CORE-COURSE GPA IS CALCULATED USING THE **BEST 16 CORE COURSES** THAT MEET BOTH PROGRESSION (10 BEFORE SEVENTH SEMESTER; SEVEN IN ENGLISH, MATH OR SCIENCE; "LOCKED IN") AND SUBJECT-AREA REQUIREMENTS.

# DIVISION I – ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- **DIVISION I –**
- *\*ATHLETICS AID, PRACTICE, AND COMPETITION*
- 16 CORE COURSES
- TEN (10) CORE COURSES COMPLETED BEFORE THE START OF SEVENTH SEMESTER. SEVEN (7) OF THE 10 MUST BE IN ENGLISH, MATH, OR NATURAL/PHYSICAL SCIENCE. "LOCKED IN" FOR CORE-COURSE GPA CALCULATION.
- CORRESPONDING TEST SCORE (ACT SUM SCORE OR SAT COMBINED SCORE) AND CORE - COURSE GPA (MINIMUM 2.300) ON SLIDING SCALE B.
- GRADUATE FROM HIGH SCHOOL.



# DIVISION I – ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- **DIVISION I ACADEMIC REDSHIRT REQUIREMENTS**
- *\*ATHLETICS AID AND PRACTICE (NO COMPETITION)*
- 16 CORE COURSES
- NO GRADES/CREDITS "LOCKED IN (REPEATED COURSES AFTER THE SEVENTH SEMESTER BEGINS MAY BE USED FOR INITIAL ELIGIBILITY).
- CORRESPONDING TEST SCORE (ACT SUM SCORE OR SAT COMBINED SCORE) AND CORE-COURSE GPA (MINIMUM 2.000) ON SLIDING SCALE B.
- GRADUATE FROM HIGH SCHOOL.

# HIGH SCHOOL TIMELINE

## GRADE 9

### *Plan*

- Start planning now! Take the right courses and earn the best grades you can.
- Ask your counselor for a list of your high school's NCAA core courses to make sure you take the right classes. Or, find your high school's list of NCAA core courses at [eligibilitycenter.org/courselist](http://eligibilitycenter.org/courselist).

## GRADE 10

### *Register*

- Register for a Certification Account or Profile Page with the NCAA Eligibility Center at [eligibilitycenter.org](http://eligibilitycenter.org).
- If you fall behind on courses, don't take shortcuts to catch up. Ask your counselor for help with finding approved courses or programs you can take.

## GRADE 11

### *Study*

- Check with your counselor to make sure you are on track to graduate on time.
- Take the ACT or SAT, and make sure we get your scores by using code **9999**.
- At the end of the year, ask your counselor to upload your official transcript.

## GRADE 12

### *Graduate*

- Take the ACT or SAT again, if necessary, and make sure we get your scores by using code **9999**.
- Request your final amateurism certification after April 1.
- After you graduate, ask your counselor to upload your final official transcript with proof of graduation.

# WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- GET GOOD GRADES!
- ATTENDING EVERY PRACTICE & WORKOUT IS THE BARE MINIMUM – DO MORE!
- RESEARCH SCHOOLS YOU ARE INTERESTED IN
  - CREATE A LIST AND FIND THE RIGHT COACH TO CONTACT (EMAIL OR TWITTER DM); THEY CANNOT RESPOND UNTIL SEP 1 OF YOUR JR YEAR
  - GET THE LIST TO COACH JACQMEIN – DISCUSS THE BEST APPROACH
- CAMP SMART
  - MUST BE AT 100% PHYSICAL CONDITION TO COMPETE
  - COLLEGE CAMPS – BE SELECTIVE AND LET THEM KNOW YOU'RE COMING
  - PRIVATE CAMPS/COMBINES (RIVALS, FBU, PREPREDZONE, ETC) – SEE COACH JACQMEIN
- TWITTER – MARKET YOURSELF AND FOLLOW COLLEGE COACHES

# WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- CONTROL WHAT YOU CAN CONTROL
  - ACADEMICS
    - A's & B's ONLY (REMEMBER ELECTIVES DO NOT COUNT TOWARDS CORE GPA)
    - TAKE SAT/ACT AS MANY TIMES AS YOU CAN
      - SUPER SCORES
  - FILM – THE BEST WAY TO GET RECRUITED
    - GREAT PLAYS
    - FINISH PLAYS
  - COMBINES / CAMPS
    - DON'T GO UNLESS YOU KNOW

- RECOMMENDATION FROM COACH/SCHOOL
- EVALUATIONS/COMBINES/CAMPS
- ACADEMIC REVIEW/TRANSCRIPTS/TEST SCORES
- FILM/SIGHT EVALUATION
- LETTERS-NOT BEING RECRUITED
- LETTERS-HAND WRITTEN!
- OFFICIAL SCHOLARSHIP OFFER
- VISITS - 5 OFFICIAL VISITS-RULE CHANGE
- DECISION PROCESS
- NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

# WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- COMBINES VS CAMPS- TELL STORY FROM WEST VIRGINIA COACH
  - COMBINES (CASE BY CASE APPROVAL)
    - HEIGHT, WEIGHT, SPEED, STRENGTH, ATHLETIC EVENTS
    - DON'T GO UNLESS YOU KNOW YOU CAN COMPETE AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL
    - HAVE YOU BEEN TRAINING FOR THESE EVENTS?
  - CAMPS (WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND TO ATTEND CAMPS WHERE YOU ARE BEING RECRUITED)
    - MORE FOOTBALL SPECIFIC
    - ACTUAL COLLEGE COACHES IN ATTENDANCE
    - HIGHER LIKELIHOOD TO BE RECRUITED
    - DREAM SCHOOL VS LOGICAL

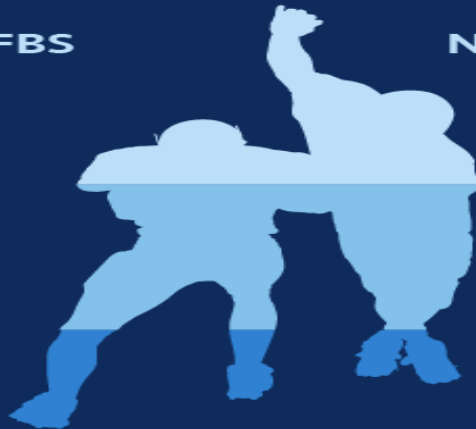

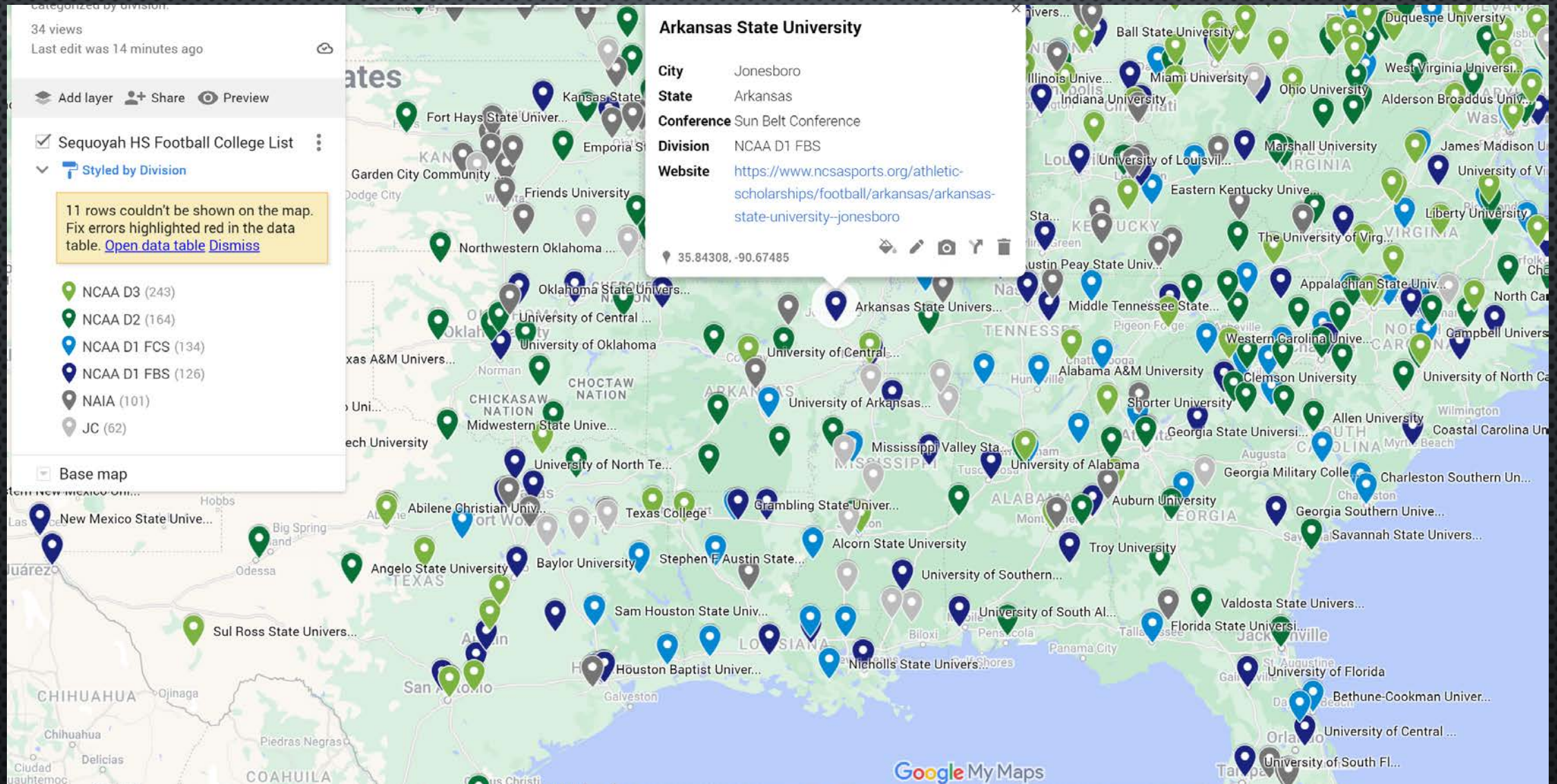

# COACH JACQ'S POINTS

- COLLEGE COACHES DECIDE WHO THEY WANT TO SEE, NOT US
- OUR JOB IS FOR THE COLLEGE TO KNOW ABOUT YOU. ONCE THEY HAVE THAT INFORMATION, EVERYTHING IS IN THEIR HANDS.
- I WILL ALWAYS BE HONEST WITH YOU.
- PATIENCE IS KEY IN THE PROCESS
